### Stakeholder Meeting No. 3

### Comfort Lake – Forest Lake Watershed District Water Quality Analysis and Design for Capital Improvement Planning

The Comfort Lake - Forest Lake Watershed District (CLFLWD) Managers invite you to attend a meeting on **Wednesday, July 25 at 1:00 p.m., at the Forest Lake City Council Chambers, 220 North Lake Street, Forest Lake, MN.** This is the third in a planned series of four meetings of a stakeholder's group for a water quality modeling and preliminary design development process which will provide the basis for the CLFLWD capital improvements plan (CIP).

*Topics to be presented at this meeting include:*

- *Load reduction goals determined from the final results of the watershed hydrology and phosphorus loading and lake response models;*
- *Load reduction project screening; and*
- *Potential costs for load reduction projects.*

*Topics to be discussed:*

- *Specific locations and ideas for load reduction and lake improvement projects.*

*Following this meeting, this list will be reviewed with the Board of Managers to develop a final list of projects to be advanced for preliminary designs and cost estimates. They will be incorporated into a prioritized list of projects and activities that will later be used to develop a CIP for the CLFLWD. The fourth meeting will be held in September to present the designs, costs and prioritization.*

In addition, existing monitoring data is likely to lead to MPCA "listing" several CLFLWD lakes as impaired waters. The listing would then lead to the need for development of TMDLs for the lakes. The Managers intend that the stakeholder process of this study will be used to satisfy part of the TMDL stakeholder process.

We welcome your participation and hope that you will contribute by sharing your knowledge of the watershed, watershed and water quality problems, ideas for improvement, or by providing input to the technical work. If you prefer, you may propose another person to represent your agency/organization in your place.
